







Following graduation from Brenham High School in 1988, Trey Holleway attended Sam Houston State University where he met my future wife, Laurie. While majoring in Criminal Justice and Police Science, Trey worked full time as a Veterinary Technician at a small animal clinic in Huntsville.
